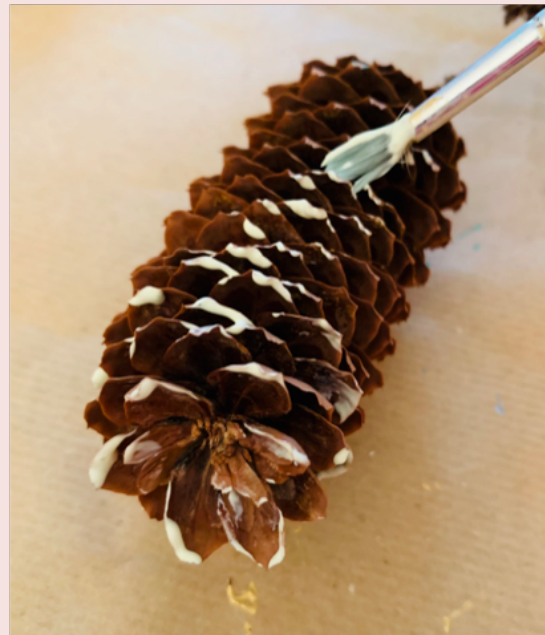
Coloring your pinecones – what you need



- ✓ calming music or an audio book
- ✓ good amount of space, comfortable seat, easy to reach the table top
- ✓ table pad for protection (can be any spare paper, cartons, etc.)
- ✓ kitchen roll (have a couple of sheets ready for use on the table)
- ✓ brushes
- ✓ paint (acrylic or watercolors both work well, fluorescent is fun) and a palette
- ✓ a cup of water (half full)
- ✓ spare carton to test your color
- ✓ pine cones of all shapes and sizes you ideally collected during a walk with your kids!

- ✓ A4, A5 or A6 paper – any size you prefer
- ✓ felt, different colored paper, all sorts of material that sticks with glue and you have ready at home
- ✓ punch and / or stencil (I used cookie cutters... of course free style also works!)

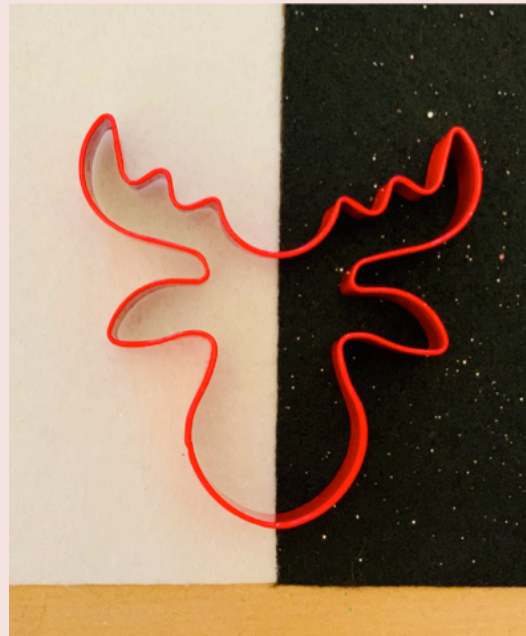

Seasonal cards - steps 'reindeer'



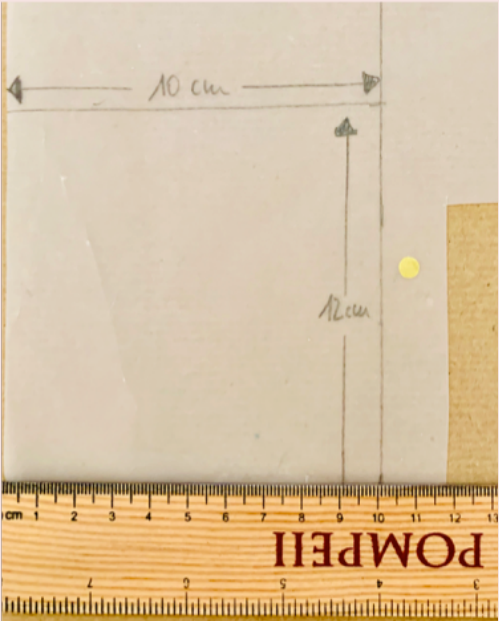
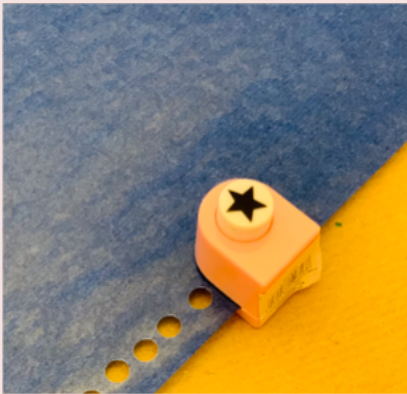
Lantern for your bedside table - what you need



- ✓ calming music or an audio book
- ✓ good amount of space, comfortable seat, easy to reach the table top
- ✓ table pad for protection (can be any spare paper, cartons, etc.)
- ✓ glue stick
- ✓ scissors – please make sure that you kids are attended when handling scissors
- ✓ one LED tea light and batteries (attention there are different light colors – white, yellow, multi,...)
- ✓ transparent paper (white and colors)
- ✓ punch or free style



Seasonal cards - go wild with your design



Tape only on top part of tea light so you can switch it off and on. When attaching tape, turn tape up so it sticks on the outside too and it can sticks to the paper.
